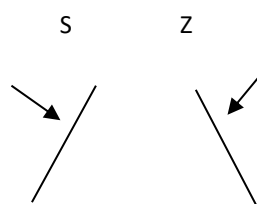

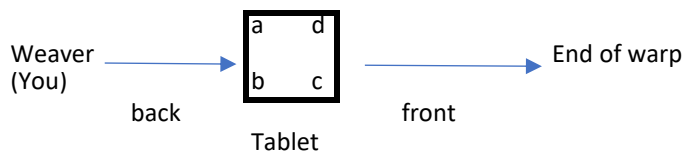
Tablet slant and threading

(When you start)



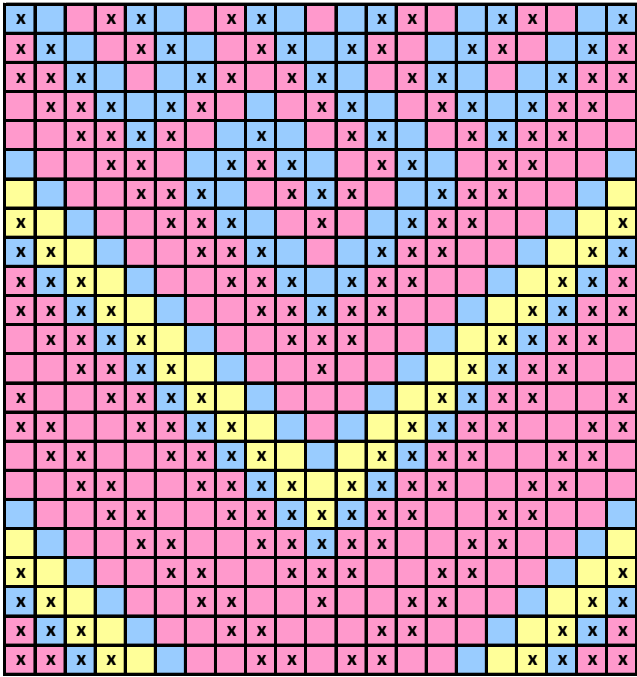
Weaving

Work the pattern from the bottom up.

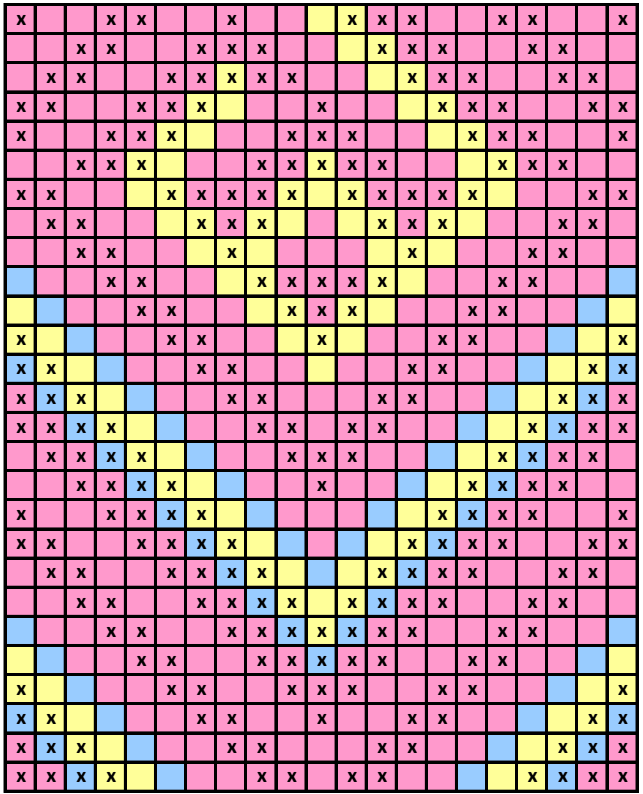
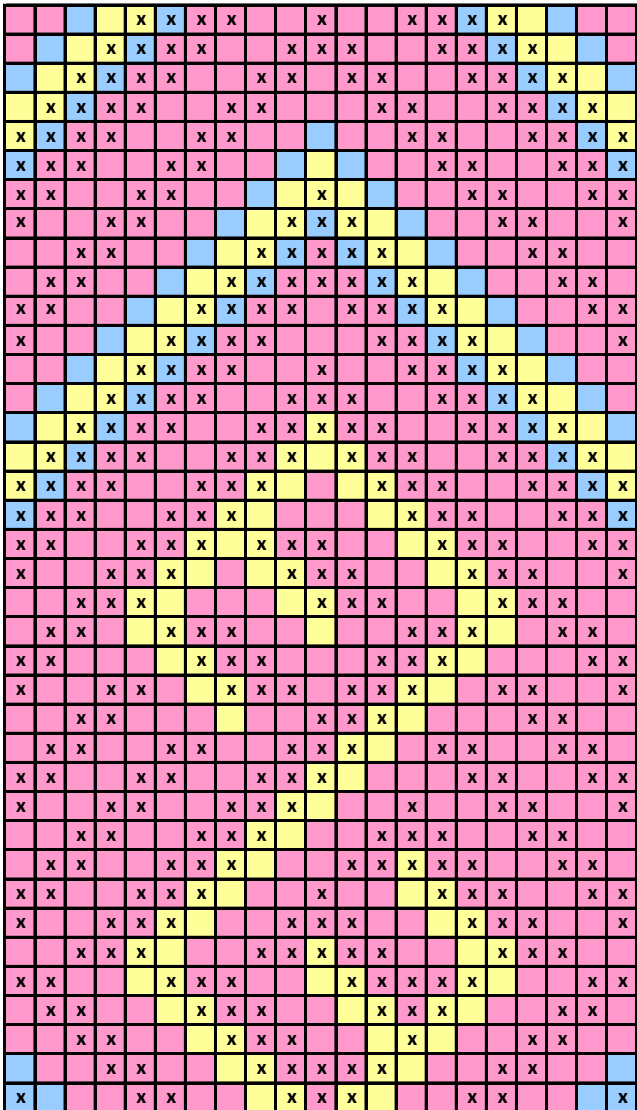
- turn forwards
